PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear protective eyewear, long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material when mixing or handling concentrate. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-858-7378 for emergency medical treatment information.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

SPRAY TANK CLEANER will remove and deactivate residual pesticide contamination from spray equipment. Use SPRAY TANK CLEANER before changing from one pesticide to another, or before storing equipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix 1½ fluid ounces (3 tablespoons) of SPRAY TANK CLEANER with 2 gallons of water in the spray reservoir. Close sprayer and shake. Maintain solution contact for at least 15 minutes. Then, pump up sprayer and spray the solution through the hose and nozzle over bare ground or concrete.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Storage:** Store in original container in a dry location inaccessible to children and pets. **Container Disposal:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
