SEQUESTAR® IRON 6% Chelate is a water-soluble iron that is readily available to plants. It can be applied to prevent or correct iron deficiency (chlorosis).

SEQUESTAR® IRON 6% is formulated with EDDHA chelate to extend iron availability to plants, especially those grown in calcareous, alkaline or acid soils. It may be dissolved in water or spread as a granule. For best results, SEQUESTAR® IRON 6% should either be incorporated into the root zone at planting, injected into the root zone, or surface applied and moved into the root zone by tillage, drenching, irrigation or rainfall.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — GENERAL

Apply SEQUESTAR® IRON 6% annually in the spring and when iron chlorosis symptoms reappear.

For trees and shrubs, uniformly broadcast or spray SEQUESTAR® IRON 6% within the drip line beneath the plant and shallowly incorporate or irrigate into the soil.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — SPECIFIC

TREE CROPS: Broadcast or spray 1/2 - 2 oz. per tree for each inch of trunk diameter. Use lower rates on sandy soils and higher rates on soil with high clay content.

ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS AND TREES: Broadcast or spray 2 oz. for small shrubs and up to 2 oz. per inch of trunk diameter for large shrubs and trees. Irrigate into soil.

ORNAMENTAL BEDDING PLANTS, VEGETABLE CROPS AND GROUNDCOVERS: Broadcast or spray 2 oz. for 100 square feet or band 2 - 4 oz. per 100 feet of row. Irrigate into soil.

LAWN AND TURF: Broadcast or spray up to 8 oz. per 1,000 square feet. Irrigate immediately after application.
