



Questions & Answers on the usage of **NUTGRASS KILLER**

What is Nutgrass Killer?

It is a post emergence selective herbicide based on the active ingredient halosulfuron-methyl for use in turf to control yellow and purple nutgrass (nutsedge). Many University research results show halosulfuron-methyl to be the most effective nutgrass control product on the market for use on turf.

What turf species can I use Nutgrass Killer on?

Bentgrass, bluegrass, fescues, ryegrass, bahiagrass, Bermuda grass, centipede grass, St. Augustine and zoysiagrass are all ok.

How do I use Nutgrass Killer?

It comes in a premeasured pouch that you open and add to 1-2 gallons of water to treat approximately 1000 sq ft. Add 2 teaspoons of a non-ionic surfactant (Herbicide Helper) for best results.

When do I apply Nutgrass Killer?

Wait until the nutgrass has reached the 3-8 leaf stage. A second treatment 6-10 weeks later may be needed if regrowth occurs.

What precaution should I observe?

Do not mow for 2 days before or 2 days after an application. Do not irrigate or rain for 4 hours after application. Only use on well established turf. You can overseed with ryegrass 2 weeks after application. Avoid drift onto desirable plants. Keep people and pets off treated area until the spray has dried.

Can I use Nutgrass Killer on ornamentals?

Yes it can be used around woody ornamental plants. Do not contact the leaves and do not use as a over the top spray.

How is Nutgrass Killer packaged?

It comes in an individual kit which contains a label and a pouch of material (.03oz). The pouch is to be opened to mix with water. There are 12 kits/case.
